

LAUNCH DAY

Saturday, April 26th 8:00 AM

Ahhhhhhh....My Favorite time of year...when we ALL get together to put the first boats in the water...signifying the new season is finally here!

Looking forward to a smooth launch and a Great 2008 Sailing Season!

Come-one... come-ALL... and help us launch!

☞ Check and replace your mooring lines if they are worn. (Replacement is good insurance)

Don't forget to tighten all shackles tightly with a wrench and also place safety ties through all mooring shackles...let's avoid skipperless boats this year!

☞ Please be at the CYC waterfront on time...8am SHARP! (and have your boat ready)

☞ We cannot launch a boat without an owner / representative present.

☞ Have a long line cleated to both your bow and stern to guide your boat while the crane has it in the air.

**<< DO NOT GO UNDERNEATH ANY BOAT WHILE IT IS IN THE AIR.
PLEASE KEEP A SAFE DISTANCE AWAY TO AVOID POTENTIAL INJURY>>**

☞ Bring a helper to assist you. We were very efficient and safe last launch day.

“Let's repeat last year's SUCCESSFUL performance”

☞ There will be a boat to tow you out to your mooring.

☞ Wearing a life vest is MANDATORY when out on the water, especially when working on your mooring lines. The water is COLD!

☞ Updated Mooring assignments are posted at www.sailcyc.com and will also be posted at the pavement restrooms by April 26th.

***** If you are not on the chart, it means your boat storage request form was not received by the Rear Commodore. *****

☞ **Boats on the blacktop that are not going to be launched by the commercial crane, must be moved off of the blacktop by April 19th.**

(Spending time moving and working around boats that are in the way, cost us more money for the crane.

A launch fee will be charged to recoup our cost for any boat that causes us delay)

☞ Shark Park is an acceptable temporary storage place for that weekend.

Only Flag Officers and the crane operator are in charge of the sequence of Launch.

It's a *requirement* to have the yellow 2007 or 07/08 registration sticker that was distributed last year on ALL trailers and all watercraft moored, dry sailed, stored on dinghy & sunfish racks, as well as behind the club by May 31st, 2008.

You may obtain these stickers at the clubhouse, through John Stevens, beginning April 26th.
