Notice of Race

1. Rules

This regatta is governed by:

- 1.1 The rules as defined in the 2005-2008 ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing
- 1.2 Boats may be subjected to measurement at any time during the regatta.

2. Worlds

- 2.1 The best, not yet qualified, sailor at this event is unconditionally invited to participate at the 2008 Sunfish World Championship
- 2.2 This is the last tune-up opportunity prior to the 2007 Sunfish Worlds.

3. Eligibility and Entry

- 3.1 Participants are strongly encouraged to be a member of the United States Sunfish Class Association. Worlds hopefuls must present their membership card at the time of registration. Participants may join USSCA at the time of registration.
- 3.2 All entrants must fill out an Entry Form at registration
 - 3.2.1 Registrations received by mail prior to July 21, include \$45 registration fee.
 - 3.2.2 Participants who register after July 21 or on-site, pay a \$50 registration fee.
- 3.3 Participants are reminded that per the class rules, 2 people may sail a boat together in the regatta so long as they sail all races this way.

5. Sailing Instructions

Sailing Instructions (SI) will be available at registration and on the CYC website. An opportunity exists to discuss any questions participants have about the SI at the skipper's meeting

6. Courses

These will be defined in the Sailing Instructions. It is likely they will be: Windward-Leeward or Olympic, with or without a start-finish in the middle, and possibly a gate in place of a leeward mark.

7. Scoring

- 7.1 The Low Point System defined per RRS A4 will be used
- 7.2 When 6 or more races have been completed, there will be one throw-out
- 7.3. One (1) Race will constitute a regatta.

8. Radio Communication

A boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications unavailable to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile/cell telephones.

9. Prizes

Trophies will be awarded to:

- 9.1 1st, 2nd & 3rd Place Overall
- 9.2 1st Junior (less than 18 at time of registration)
- 9.3 1st GrandMaster (At least age 50 at time of registration)
- 9.4 1st Female Sailor
- 9.5 1st Local Sailor
- 9.6 Mobil Gas Debit cards with a \$25 face value will be awarded to the top 3 participants not from Monroe, Ontario, Yates or Wayne Counties

10. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY:

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with, prior to, during, or after the regatta. Local lake regulations require that a USGC approved life jacket is on board while on the water.
